

**PRESIDIUM MEETING
BUDAPEST, HUNGARY
JUNE 21, 2006**


The meeting was called to order at 10:00am. All members of the Presidium were present, including Balazs Csibri, interpreter for Peter Szanto.

1. President's remarks: The President asked Bill to take care of all paper work including agendas for all Presidium and AGM meetings for the next year. He asked Jorn to take care of all memberships, old and new, and to keep a record of all member dues, etc.
2. There was a short discussion on the AGM, on how we could improve the relationship between the Presidium and the general membership.
3. Competition Committee: Mr. Wendt reported on the following competitions and who would be the Supervisor and Chairman of Judges.

4. Nils-Hakan Carlzon reported that there was a request from O. Sahim Dalli to have his IDO judging license reinstated and this request was granted. Jadran will notify him that his request was granted.
 5. Bill Fowler reported on the findings of the Disciplinary committee meeting in regards to the investigation of unethical and unprofessional behavior of an IDO adjudicator during two IDO events. Three judges wrote letters alleging that Mrs. Ilona Sulcova misled them into believing that only Hip Hop dancers should be judged during the World Cup Production Category, although the judges were just informed by the Chairman, Mr. Bill Fowler, that all IDO disciplines should be judged equally. Mrs. Sulcova pleaded guilty to all three charges and apologized for her actions. The fourth letter, alleging that Mrs. Sulcova tried to sway a judge to vote in a particular manner, was investigated. Although Mrs. Sulcova stated that she never meant any malice in her conversation, the committee felt that the evidence she provided, was not strong enough to warrant the charges being dismissed. IDO's legal advisor, advised Mrs. Sulcova that she had just been given a gift from the Disciplinary Committee, because in actuality there were two separate charges brought against her, which could have warranted two separate decisions, making it a total of three separate convictions of unethical and unprofessional behavior, which could have resulted in her license being suspended for life. The committee made the following recommendations to the Presidium:
 - Mrs. Sulcova's license to judge at IDO events be suspended for no less than one and one half years (1 ½) but no longer than a three-year period.
 - Before her license to judge is reinstated, she must take an official IDO Examination Seminar and Test. This must be done at an Official Seminar and if it is just taken at a National seminar, there must be at least one member of the Disciplinary Committee present.
 - That Mrs. Sulcova is warned that this is her second conviction for unethical and unprofessional behavior and if she is convicted of such behavior again that it may result in a permanent revocation of her license to judge IDO events.
 - She was advised that the earliest that she could apply for reinstatement was January 1, 2008, and that she would have to surrender her license to the IDO Executive Secretary, Kirsten Dan Jensen.
 6. The Presidium voted to accept these recommendations and notify Mrs. Sulcova of it's decision.
 7. President Carlzon then asked Bill to write a letter to Mrs. Sulcova, in his name, advising her of the decision of the Presidium and that she would have to surrender her license book until she has complied with the decision.
 8. Bill reported on the letter from Ladd Anderson regarding using the IDO logo on Cobalt Flux, dance platforms. Permission will be granted to do this and a copy of our past contract with Machine Dance and the guidelines on how the IDO logo must be used.
 9. Dates and venues were discussed and will be announced shortly.
 10. Jannie Dan Jensen was given permission to make new IDO license books in white.
 11. Jadran brought up the problem of organizers using National judges and teachers without going through the National Federation.
 12. Jadran asked that all ranking lists be put on the Internet.
 13. There was a discussion of an automatic ranking system on the Internet.
 14. Implementation dates were set for all proposals at the AGM in Budapest, 2006.
 15. There was a discussion of VIP judges and how often they should be used.

16. The next Presidium meeting will be held March 23 – 25, 2007, in Czech Republic or Prague.
17. The next AGM will be June 16 – 18, 2007, venue to be announced.
18. In closing the meeting, the President extended a sincere thank you to Peter Szanto for hosting this year's AGM and Presidium meeting.
19. The meeting will be adjourned at 1:30pm.
