Bauhinia Cup International Dance Championships 2018

The Bauhinia Cup International Dance Championships is a dance competition set up by the Hong Kong Dance Federation ("HKDF") for the continuation of the "Bauhinia Cup Dance Championship" vision which is to enable Hong Kong and international dance artists to produce excellent works in face of the challenge of culture preservation in traditional dance and ever demanding creative presentation. The success of last few years has gained itself a cultural brand among local and international experts and fostered the cultural exchange in international level.

Concurrent with the 40th anniversary of HKDF, *The Bauhinia Cup International Dance Championships* not only retain "solo/duo/trio" and "ensemble" category, but also set up juvenile group with "ensemble" category in response to the growing demands from the public. We welcome outstanding students, groups and companies from local, mainland China and overseas to enroll and share the stage and experiences with other professionals and experts. This is an invaluable exchange that would broaden the dancers' horizons through viewing and anticipation into the competition.

Participating organization / institution could only enter the competition through video audition, only the accepted finalists could join the Final held in Hong Kong. Each institute / individual could enroll no more than TWO dance programs to showcase the latest level of dance creation in their country or region. The winner of local "Bauhinia Cup Dance Competition" will represent Hong Kong in the international competitions.

Competition Details:

1. Dance Type and Format

All dance types including Chinese Dance, Ballet, Oriental and Western National Dance, Jazz, and Modern Dance are accepted.

A. Solo, Duo & Trio Section

(Open) Duration: No more than 4 Minutes

B. **Ensemble** Section – 8 dancers or above a group

(Open) Duration: No more than 7 Minutes

(Junior - Age 15 or below) (New) Duration: No more than 5 Minutes

**The order of appearance is solely arranged by the Competition Committee and independent of the dance type.

3. Rules and regulations:

- 1. Competitors entering Bauhinia Cup International Dance Championships (Open) should be 16 years old or above, where those entering (Junior) session should be 15 years or below as of 31 July, 2018.
- 2. Original Choreography is defined as new dance choreographed after 1 January 2017 in which the theme, content, structure, style and choreography are newly conceived; no original choreography before the said date, rearrangement and reproduction will be accepted. All entries declared to be original choreographies but are in fact adaptions or plagiarisms will lead to disqualification or deprivation of award; the Competition Committee will not assume any legal obligations incurred by infringements on copyright.
- 3. All entries must be submitted together with the video recording on or before deadline, after selection by the jury, a formal notice of entry will be issued; The Committee has the absolute right to accept or reject any application.
- 4. Adjudication is based on the originality, level of choreography, mastery of style, performance and techniques of the dancer(s).
- 5. Basic stage lighting shall be provided throughout the competitions.
- 6. Adjudicator panel holds all rights in making final decision.
- 7. In order to maintain a fair competition, no participant or delegates of competing schools or organizations shall contact any adjudicator privately prior to the event; failure to observe the rule will lead to disqualification.
- 8. The Competition Committee has the right of videoing and re-playing dances entered in the competition; all participating organizations are requested to sign a Letter of Consent concerned.
- 9. Finalists shall enter into Final competition and Winners performance cum prize presentation ceremony.
- 10. Each participant shall observe and comply with the criteria set in each category and section. Any violation of rules shall be penalized by the adjudicator panel or committee of the Championships without prior notice. The committee reserves all rights in interpretation, determination and makes final decision on all the rules and regulations of the Championships.

 - Formal invitation will be sent by the Competition Committee on 30 May 2018. Oversea participants should take time to arrange for coming to Hong Kong once the formal invitation has been issued.
